Phoenix Crane Employees:
Effective Immediately, you are no longer required to have yard time authorized on your weekly timesheet. You must still list yard time along with ticket time on your time sheet as you've always done. Now, however, in order for you to be paid yard time, it is required of everyone to punch in/punch out on our new time clock. You must use the clock. Failure to use the clock nullifies any claim to yard time you may have. Ticket time is not affected. anyone with ticket time will be paid as usual. However, you still need to list both ticket time as well as yard time on your time sheets.

Clock in to begin the day, clock out when leaving for lunch, clock in upon returning from lunch, clock out when you leave for the day. clocking in someone other than yourself will result in immediate termination.
